# 052/21 HOLBETON PARISH COUNCIL CLIMATE CHANGE SUB-COMMITTEE UPDATE

The Holbeton Parish Council Climate Change subcommittee held its most recent meeting on Tuesday the  $6^{th}$  July in Holbeton Village Hall.

There were 4 members of the subcommittee present, plus 2 further parishioners.

• The River Erme sewage pollution. The letter to Sir Gary Streeter has been signed by a number of parishioners and will be brought to the meeting to facilitate any councillors who wish to sign it to do so. The letter will then be delivered by hand.

# 052/21 HOLBETON PARISH COUNCIL CLIMATE CHANGE SUB-COMMITTEE UPDATE (continued)

At the last parish council meeting it was agreed that an approach would be made to the River Yealm Water Quality Group (RYWQG), headed by Cllr Liz Hitchins, Chair of Brixton Parish Council. Her response has been circulated. Their preference is for a separate River Erme Water Quality Group to be formed involving the relevant councils. These include Ermington Parish Council, Ivybridge Town Council, and possibly Kingston Parish Council.

I attended the most recent zoom meeting of RYWQG on the  $5^{th}$  July. They had talks from Rob Price (Environment Agency) and Simon Browning (South West Rivers Trust). The focus was on increasing the amount of monitoring using volunteers. I will continue to attend these meetings as an observer.

Resolved the parish council will approach the other relevant councils with a view to the formation of a River Erme Water Quality Group.

- The environmental tip of the month for August will be advice on reducing the items flushed down our toilets in view of the sewage problem. This was originally written by Liz Hitchins for the Brixton local parish magazine and will be reproduced with her permission.
- The parish wide LED survey, planned for this autumn, will be recruiting volunteers. A more careful count of the number of households (including Flete estate holiday lets) has revealed that as well as the 200 leaflets already printed another 100 are needed.

It was RESOLVED, an additional expenditure of £34.50 from the s106 fund in addition to the £69 already approved for printing them by the parish council.

• The Holbeton Parish Council Environmental Action Plan has been reviewed 1 year on; it was RESOLVED to approve a number of amendments. The changes are shown highlighted below:

Action 2: "Providing leadership to the parish on climate change and environmental and biodiversity, and lobby on their behalf."

Action 17a. Monitor and promote the health of the Erme estuary.

Action 33. Encouraging biodiversity within the parish (B).

- The allotment holders' contract has been reviewed and several changes that aim to reduce the use of insecticides, herbicides, poisons and artificial fertilisers are proposed. This is a separate agenda item.
- AONB proposed Life On The Edge project. I have been approached by Dominic Acland for the AONB asking for our support for a huge project designed to improve the natural habitat for wildlife, especially invertebrates. This stretches from Berry Head near Brixham to Wembury. They plan to have Holbeton as one of what they call hot spots, i.e., give us more attention and resources. They have other organisations involved including Buglife, Plantlife, the National Trust and the Flete Estate.

Their main source of finding will come from the Heritage Lottery Fund (£1.8 million), and they will be applying in August. Even if successful at that stage, it will take until 2023 before final approval. The project will start in 2024 and continue for 5 years. There will be 3 full-time staff and 1 part-time during that time. The main call on the parish will be for volunteers.

The parish council RESOLVED to approve participation if and when funding is obtained.

The next meeting of the Holbeton Parish Council Climate Change subcommittee will be on Tuesday the 3<sup>rd</sup> August 2021.
