#### 108/23 HOLBETON PARISH COUNCIL CLIMATE CHANGE SUB-COMMITTEE UPDATE - Clir Baumer

The Holbeton Parish Council Climate Change subcommittee meeting took place on Tuesday the  $3^{rd}$  October. The main topics under consideration are:

- Follow up from the River Erme sewage public meeting Friday 18<sup>th</sup> November 2022
- i) The meeting with representatives from South West Water on the 21<sup>st</sup> March 2023 to consider how to get the most from a proposed new surface water drain extending the existing from the school to part way up Vicarage Hill.
  - A response is still awaited from the SWW representatives on the status of the Pell Frischmann report into the current state of Holbeton Village's surface water arrangements.
- ii) Support the development of a whole river group, the River Erme Parish and Town Councils Group.

  The WATER group is well advanced in preparations for designated Bathing Beach status at Coastguards Cottages.

  They now have more than 1,000 responses to their public consultation, including Holbeton Parish Council, and

They now have more than 1,000 responses to their public consultation, including Holbeton Parish Council, and letters of support from South Hams District council and the local MP Sir Gary Streeter.

The application is to be made before the end of October. DEFRA is not expected to publish a decision before April 2024.

The date for the next meeting of the River Erme Councils is Thursday the 2<sup>nd</sup> November.

## An electric vehicle (EV) car charger for the village

I have received a response to my email sent on behalf of the parish council to the parishioner who had kindly agreed to donate an EV charger:

"I'm happy to confirm 1 charger is reserved for the Church Hill development. I assume the Parish Council will take on the administration of the charger or find someone to take that role. I suggested using the CoCharger app as that seemed a practical and light touch solution but the offer of the charger comes without conditions or constraints. The Parish Council are free to follow that suggestion or not at their discretion.

Some other points for consideration if you haven't already thought them through:

- how will the electricity for the charger will be supplied and paid for, will the PC contract with the energy provider directly?
- if the scheme is successful how easy will it be to expand the provision in future?

Kind regards"

Holbeton Parish Council has agreed to clarify the planned arrangements for managing the public car park that will be part of the Church Hill development. We need to ensure that the public car park is set up so as to make it easy to expand the EV charging facilities in the future.

It will be important to ensure that the electricity is being sold at a price consistent with a domestic EV charger, and that the arrangements needed for managing an EV charger space will make it available for as many as possible local residents. RESOLVED that a letter of thanks is sent to the parishioner offering the EV charger.

Section 106 funding request for an infrared camera and training in assessing home insulation
 This device is attached to a smartphone to identify where heat is being lost from peoples' homes. The advantage of this combination is that a paper copy of the images can be created from the smartphone, making detail easier to see.

## 108/23 HOLBETON PARISH COUNCIL CLIMATE CHANGE SUB-COMMITTEE UPDATE - Clir Baumer

A second parishioner has asked to assist with this project. Both will obtain training in the use of the camera, its interpretation and knowledge of where householders can obtain unbiased professional advice. The project will involve advertising and encouraging parishioners to have their property assessed. A copy of the application is attached.

This was considered by the climate change subcommittee and it is recommended that funding for this potentially important project is approved. RESOLVED the parish council will fund an infrared camera and training in assessing home insulation at a maximum cost of £600. ACTION: Cllr West

#### • Continuation of the 4 page environmental section for Holbeton News

This started in October 2022 and was agreed by the parish council for one year. This cost £240 for 12 months, and was paid for out of the section 106 funds from Creacombe solar farm. During that time, we have managed to provide 4 pages of news and information, including regular YCE updates and most months an environmental tip of the month.

At the climate change subcommittee 2 weeks ago, it was agreed that members of the committee would informally seek parishioners' views on the environmental section. RESOLVED the parish council will renew the funding for a further 12 months.

The next meeting of the Holbeton Parish Council Climate Change subcommittee will be on Tuesday the 7 November 2023.

Cllr Sherrell is waiting for SHDC to make the electrics safe and the water tap in the gents needs to be replaced.

## 110/23 HOLBETON PLAY PARK - Cllr Callcut

Cllr Calcutt reported that a parishioner is keen to start a parent's group to look after the play park. The swing bridge needs to be assessed, filler required in the steps and the wooden sculpture. The entrance path requires cleaning and the weeds growing through the matting under the slide to be addressed.

Cllr Sherrell has met with Mr Mildmay-White of Flete Estate in connection with a small overgrown boundary area, which Flete would like cleared. Cllr Calcutt will liaise with the parent group. ACTION: Cllr Calcut

There is an area by the BBQ area where Sumac is growing out of the hedge, and needs to be removed. The orchard is historically is registered organic which means Roundup can't be used as it will lose certification.
