Dear Sir / Madam.

This letter is to give you some further information about the works that we are carrying out from Orchard Hill junction to Western Lodge Cross on the A379 at the end of February for a period of a 5 days.

Due to the nature of the works a road closure is required and a full signed diversion route will be signposted on the Highway.

I apologise in advance for any inconvenience caused, including construction noise. We will endeavour to keep all disruption to a minimum.

Our planned programme for the delivery of the work is:

• Monday 26th February until Friday 1st March.

Extensive patching on the A379 between Orchard Hill junction to Western Lodge Cross and some related ancillary works where appropriate.

Please note- although the road will be closed, Public Transport Buses/School Buses will be allowed access through the site at a very low speed under controlled measures, and delays must be expected accordingly. Access will also be maintained for emergency vehicles throughout.


Please see the below map for the extent of the road closure.





The official diversion will be as follows- following the **blue dotted line**.

Please note, some important information, in that <u>Red Lion Hill in Brixton village remains closed</u> due to the construction of Sherford Town, and we would urge that all traffic remains on the A379 into Elburton and follows the diversion route back towards the A38. Whilst drivers with local knowledge may use local roads, <u>Devon County Council will not be promoting them prior or during the road</u> closure and we ask that all drivers use and follow the official diversion route.
