If you use paper then use recycled as it has less environmental impact because;

fewer trees are felled,

recycling paper means less material going to landfill,

less water is used in its production

less pollutants are produced

production uses fewer toxic chemicals than needed to bleach virgin pulp.

If made in the UK there is less carbon produced in transport.

Ecoleaf (Suma) 100% Recycled: fibre from UK

Essential 100% Recycled: fibre from UK

Traidcraft 100% Recycled: fibre from UK

Who Gives a Crap 100% Recycled: fibre from China Bamboo: fibre from China

(50% of profits donated to fund sanitation projects)

The Cheeky Panda Bamboo: FSC 100% from China

Emerald 70% Tree-Free: Sugarcane bagasse, bamboo & Emp; FSC 100%. From USA

FSC=Forest Stewardship Council.

Price -compare cost per sheet rather than per roll as they vary hugely in size.
